

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#### 4.0" SLIP-ON EXHAUST

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#### NOTE

RCX exhaust systems may not meet EPA and/or carb emissions in the State of California or other States with similar emission control restrictions. ## **REMOVAL INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1. Remove saddlebags.(refer to owner's manual for saddlebag removal)
- 2. Remove the two rear 13mm hex head bolts that attach the mufflers to the support brackets. (These hex head bolts will be reused when installing the new RCX mufflers)
- 3. Remove the two 10mm bolts that attach the front of the muffler to the support bracket.
- 4. Remove the spacer plate and nut plate from the front muffler mount. (These will be reused when installing the new RCX mufflers)
- 5. Remove front heat shield clamp that is located at the muffler inlet.
- 6. Loosen both exhaust clamps that secure the mufflers to the head pipe.
- 7. Remove the two rubber pads from each muffler. (These will be reused when installing the new RCX mufflers)
- 8. Carefully remove the mufflers by sliding them off each head pipe.
- 9. Remove the stock exhaust clamps from the front end of each muffler. (These will be reused when installing the new RCX mufflers.

#### **INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1. Remove mufflers from packaging and place on a blanket or any non abrasive surface.
- 2. Slide on stock exhaust clamps onto the front end of each muffler. NOTE: Position the exhaust clamp so that you can get to the nut after installation.
- 3. Carefully slide mufflers onto the head pipes.
- 4. Attach the rubber pads to the mounting brackets on each muffler.
- 5. Install the rear 13mm hex head bolts to attach the mufflers to the muffler support brackets. NOTE: Do not fully tighten, draw muffler level with bracket.
- 6. Insert the spacer plate between the front muffler mount and support bracket on each muffler
- 7. Insert the nut plate inside of the front muffler mount and position to where all mounting holes are in alignment.
- 8. Insert the 10mm bolts through the front support brackets and spacer plates.
- 9. Thread 10mm bolts into the nut plate to secure the front muffler mount to the support bracket.
- 10. Tighten the exhaust clamps that secure the mufflers to the head pipes.
- 11. Tighten the factory hex head bolts that secure the muffler to the support brackets.
- 12. Be sure to check and tighten all hardware before starting the motorcycle.

**NOTE:** When installing a new set of chrome mufflers, make sure your hands are clean and free of oil.

After installation, thoroughly clean pipes with a soft cloth and cleaning solution
(chrome wax/polish, glass cleaner, etc.) that will leave no residue before starting the motorocycle.



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
