


Instructions:

This mount system is designed to mount into one of the fork tubes above the top triple clamp on many European motorcycles. (Left or right side)

The mount is shipped fully assembled so it is necessary to remove the shaft from the mount base in order to access the mounting screw inside the base pivot.

- 1. Slide the mount over the fork tube, rotate into position and tighten the 9/64 socket head screw to tighten the mount.
- 2. To adjust the shaft angle and height. Remove the 10-32 socket head screw from the lower end of the mount with the supplied 5/32" hex wrench and remove the shaft and set aside.
- 3. Loosen the Base Pivot mounting screw (1/8" hex wrench) and adjust base pivot to desired angle and re-tighten the screw.
- 4. Re-install the shaft from step 2.
- 5. Adjust the shaft and top socket angle to suit and snug all the fasteners. The 17mm top will accept any TechMount 4th generation accessory.

Upon inspection by High Gear, the Mount or parts thereof which prove to be defective will be repaired or replaced at no charge.

THE WARRANTY SET FORTH ABOVE IS EXCLUSIVE AND NO OTHER WARRANTY, WHETHER WRITTEN OR ORAL, IS EXPRESSED OR IMPLIED. HIGH GEAR SPECIFICALLY DISCLAIMS THE IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY AND FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE.

The warranties set forth herein apply only to the original customer and are conditional upon the customer giving prompt notice to High Gear of any discovered defects during the Warranty Period. High Gear shall not be responsible for any other defects or damage, including, but not limited to, any defects or damage caused by or resulting from: (a) alterations to the Mount by anyone other than High Gear; (b) accident; (c) damage due to an intentional or negligent act of a third party; (d)

abuse or negligence; (e) wear and tear.; (f) mishandling; (g) failure to use the Mount in a safe and reasonable manner, or (h) force majeure. If the Mount, in the judgment of High Gear, shows evidence of having been altered, modified or repaired without the authorization of High Gear, the warranties set forth herein shall not apply.

High Gear's cumulative liability for damages of any kind whatsoever arising out of the use or possession of the Mount, regardless of the form of action, whether in contract or tort, including negligence or strict liability, shall be limited to the purchase price of the Mount that caused the damages or that is the subject matter of, or is directly related, to the cause of action.
