T-40 Torx Wrench 6mm Allen Wrench	

- 1. Start by removing the stock seat using a T-40 torx wrench and 6mm Allen wrench.
- 2. Remove the bolts on the handrails to expose the seat bolts, using a T-40 torx wrench.
- 3. Remove the two bolts securing the seat, using a 6mm Allen wrench.
- 4. Remove the seat.
- 5. Saddle mounts like stock and bolts directly to the Indian subframe just like the OEM seat. Mounting brackets are included and come pre-installed on the seat (Figure 1).
- 6. To install your new Corbin saddle, start by sliding the two front tabs <u>under</u> the OEM mounting pegs (*Figure 2*), making sure its pushed all the way forward. Next lower the rear of the seat and secure with the stock bolts.

NOTE: The rear bracket is adjustable (*Figure 3*).

NOTE: Put WD40 on the rubber grommets to help slide the seat forward

7. Reinstall the handrails.
