## Installation Instructions:

1. Park on a level surface and shut off motorcycle. Ensure the engine has time to cool before installation. Protect the areas of the motorcycle where you will be working.
2. You will need to remove the existing backrest cover. Open the trunk and remove the screw shown in Fig. 1 and set aside. There is another screw at the bottom of the backrest shown in Fig. 2. To access, remove the three screws shown in Fig. 2 and the backrest will flex out from the trunk. Remove the small screw indicated in Fig. 2 and remove the faceplate cover and set aside. Replace the three screws removed holding the backrest. Be careful not to overtighten.
3. Insert the armrest attachment link through the backside of the hinge mechanism. Fig. 3
4. Slide the armrest into the hole exposed by the plastic cover and align its mounting holes with the armrest attachment link. Note: The accessory mounting hole in the arm faces out. Fig. 4
5. Install the provided screws with washers through the armrest attachment link. Fig. 5
6. Repeat steps 2-5 on the other side of the motorcycle.

NOTE: If installing an accessory mount remove the arm plug and refer to the directions included with the mount. Fig. 6
