

MOUNTING SUGGESTIONS:

Harley-Davidson[®] Softail FLSTC 2016-2017

Solo and Passenger Seats

Hardware: Solo: Passenger seat:
Small retaining Stock fender screw

Small retaining washers x 2

Stock fender nuts (or

Mustang part 78032) **Tools needed:** Phillips screwdriver

These seats will install on the following motorcycles. If your motorcycle is not listed, please contact Mustang for fitment.

- FLSTC Heritage Classic 2016-2017
- FLSTN Deluxe 2016-2017 (without rack)

If you are using the standard rack on the Deluxe, we recommend using the Mustang seats designed for use with the rack.

Removal of stock seat:

- 1. Remove the rear 1/4"-20 fender screw with a Phillips screwdriver and set it aside. The stock rear fender screw will be used to attach your new Mustang seat.
- 2. Slide the passenger seat up and back to remove.
- 3. Remove the two stock screws from behind the solo, and slide the solo seat up and back to remove.

Installation of Mustang seat:



Solo:

1. Remove one of the large retaining washers from the fender studs and replace with the supplied small retaining washer. Repeat for other stud. **Note: Do not remove both retaining washers at the same time!**

- 2. Insert the solo's nose tab into the frame mount behind the tank.
- 3. Align the rear chrome brackets onto the fender studs and attach stock slotted nuts (or Mustang part 78032). Tighten securely.

Passenger seat:

- 1. The two notches at the front of the baseplate engage the slotted nuts mounting the solo seat.
- 2. Secure the rear bracket with the stock $\frac{1}{4}$ "-20 x $\frac{1}{2}$ " screw.

Enjoy the comfort and custom look of your new Mustang seat!
