

MOUNTING SUGGESTIONS:

2002-2015 - Solo and Passenger Seat

Passenger seat:

screw x 2

Stock rear fender screw

1/4"-20 x 3/4" Phillips

Hardware: Solo seat:

Chrome rear mounting

bracket

10-32 x 5/8" screw x 2 Black retaining clip x 2 8mm x 15mm chrome

buttonhead screw White nylon washer

Tools needed: 3mm Allen wrench

5mm Allen wrench

8mm wrench

Phillips screwdriver

Removal of Stock Seat:

- 1. Remove the rear fender screw with a 5mm Allen wrench and set aside. This screw will be used to mount the Mustang passenger seat.
- 2. Locate the pull ring on the left side of the seat and pull it to release the seat from the fender bracket.
- 3. Lift the seat up and back to remove from motorcycle.

4. Remove the fender bracket (including nut, bolts and washers) from the fender using a 3mm Allen wrench and an 8mm wrench. Insert the black retaining clips into the two outermost holes in the fender.



Installation of Mustang Seat:

Solo only:

- 1. Attach the chrome bracket to the rear of the solo using the provided 10-32 \times 5/8" Phillips screws. (See photo on page 1.) Tighten securely, but do not overtighten.
- 2. Insert nose tab into the frame mount under the tank.
- 3. Position the white nylon washer between the rear solo bracket and the center fender hole and attach with the provided $8mm \times 15mm$ screw. Tighten securely with a 5mm Allen wrench.



Solo and passenger seat:

- 1. Install the 8mm x 15mm screw provided with the solo into the open fender hole to prevent splash-through from the rear tire.
- 2. Attach the front brackets on the rear seat to the rear of the solo with the provided 1/4"-20 x 3/4" Phillips screws. Tighten securely, but do not overtighten. Do not use the chrome solo bracket when installing with the passenger seat.



- 3. Insert nose tab into the frame mount under the tank.
- 4. Position the white nylon washer between the rear passenger bracket and the rear fender hole and attach with the stock rear fender screw. Tighten securely with a 5mm Allen wrench.

Enjoy the comfort and custom look of your new Mustang seat!
