

Mounting Suggestions Yamaha Road Star 1600/1700 1999-&\$% One-Piece Seat

Tools Required:

- 10 mm socket
- 10 mm wrench

Hardware:

- Stock 6 mm Rear Fender Bolt
- White Nylon Washer x1 (Included)



Baseplate Features:

The one-piece, marine-grade fiberglass baseplate is a direct replacement for the stock, two-piece seat. Rubber bumpers are positioned to prevent the seat from touching the frame and fender.

Stock Seat Removal Steps

- 1. Open seat latch by turning ignition key counter-clockwise.
- 2. Remove stock seat.
- 3. Remove mounting bracket by removing the three 6 mm bolts with a 10 mm socket. This bracket is <u>not required</u> for the Mustang seat.
- 4. Reinstall the three 6 mm Allen bolts into the fender to fill the holes.
- 5. Remove 8 mm mounting bolt with a 10 mm socket

Mounting of Mustang Seat

- 1. Set seat on frame, aligning the rear bracket with the mounting hole in the fender.
- 2. Slide the supplied white nylon washer under the bracket and then install the stock 8 mm bolt. DO NOT TIGHTEN YET!
- 3. Align the seat nose bracket with the frames latch. Push the seat nose down to lock.
- 4. Now tighten the stock 8 mm bolt with a 10 mm wrench.
- 5. Turn the ignition key counter-clockwise to unlock the seat so it can be moved to the left to check the engine oil level.
