

MOUNTING SUGGESTIONS:

Yamaha V-Star 1100 Classic/Silverado '00-09 – Solo and Passenger Seat

Hardware: Stock 8mm screws/nut

White nylon washer

Tools needed: Metric wrenches

Removal of stock seat:

- 1. Remove the 8mm screw or nut from the fender.
- 2. Slide passenger seat back to remove.



- 3. Remove 8mm screw behind the solo.
- 4. Slide solo back and up to remove.

Installation of Mustang seat:

- 1. Slide nose bracket on the front of the solo into the receiver at the base of the gas tank.
- 2. Secure the rear of the solo to the fender with the stock 8mm screw.
- 3. Slide the passenger seat's front bracket under the fender receiver and align the rear bracket with the fender mount.
- 4. On models with a fender stud, put the white nylon washer between the fender and the seat's rear bracket and secure with the stock nut. On models with a fender hole, secure the bracket to the fender with the stock 8mm screw.
