

STEP 2 Gently pull up and out on the existing oil cooler cover. It

hooks over the oil cooler on the top and has posts that pull out from rubber grommets on the bottom. Remove the cover and set aside, it will not be reused.

STEP 3 Loosen the two Torx screws that attach the oil cooler to the frame to enable you to tip the oil cooler forward slightly. PIC 2

STEP 4 Line up the bottom posts on the new Oil Cooler and Regulator cover with the rubber grommets on the bottom of the oil cooler. While holding the back of the oil cooler, push the cover in and hook the top of the cover over the top of the oil cooler. PIC 3 and PIC 4 The cover should snap securely in place.

LOOSEN THESE


STEP 5 Check for clearance between the new cover and the fairing lowers. The lowers may have to be adjusted outward. You may need to tie the clutch cable to the frame to eliminate any scratching. PIC 4

STEP 6 Tighten the two Torx screws from Step 3 securely.

NOTE: Periodically check the cover to make sure there is no chaffing of

the oil lines or the cover.

ATTENTION! It is the installer's responsibility to ensure that all of the fasteners (including pre-assembled) are tightened before operation of the motorcycle. Küryakyn will not issue a warranty on components lost due to improper installation. Periodic maintenance may be required.
