PLEASE NOTE

It is the installers' responsibility to make sure all fasteners (including pre-assembled) are tightened before operation of motorcycle. Küryakyn will not warranty components that are lost due to improper installation. Periodic maintenance may be required.

TOOLS SUGGESTED

Allen wrenches, 1/4" and #17 drill bits, drill, wire stripper/crimper, 1/2" wrench, sandpaper or steel wool.

ATTENTION! A factory service manual may be helpful in performing this installation. Do not attempt to perform this installation if you are not confident in your ability to complete all steps in the procedure; consult a trained technician.

ATTENTION! When routing the wiring harness, be sure to keep the wiring away from any moving parts. Küuryakyn **WILL NOT** warranty any electrical component that fails due to pinched, crimped, broken, abraded, or frayed wires.

PROCEDURE

- **STEP 1** Remove the front fender; refer to your factory service manual for more information.
- **STEP 2** On the base for the eagle, remove the fastener securing the bulb assembly to the base; this will give you access to the fastener through-hole.
- **STEP 3** Determine the best location for the ornament; mask the area with tape to prevent scratching the surface. Using the base plate as a template, mark the location of the two mounting holes and the wiring through hole on the fender.
- **STEP 4** Use a #17 drill bit to drill the two mounting holes; use a 1/4" drill bit to drill the through hole. Install the rubber grommet into the 1/4" through hole.
- **STEP 5** On the underside of the fender, use sandpaper or steel wool to clean a small area around one of the mounting holes. This will be used as a chassis ground; be sure to clean down to bare metal.

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STEP 6 Secure the base to the fender using the supplied fasteners. Be sure to secure one end of the wire with the ring terminals under the chassis ground fastener. Refer to <u>PIC.1</u> and <u>FIG.1</u>.

STEP 7 Secure the bulb assembly to the base; secure the other end of the wire from the chassis ground to the bulb assembly. See PIC.2.


STEP 8 Run the wire from the positive side of the bulb along the inside of the fender to the exit point. Follow the existing fender tip light wiring, if so equipped. Use silicone or duct tape to secure the wiring to the fender so that it will not come in contact with the tire.

STEP 9 Place the chrome eagle over the base and secure it with the supplied fastener. Install the gold hot spot into the head of the fastener.

STEP 10 Reinstall the fender; refer to your factory service manual for more information.


STEP 11 Connect the positive wire to the appropriate power source, such as the ignition switch, low beam power wire, or fender tip light power light, if equipped. Be sure to insulate the connection. The wire can be soldered or use crimp-type terminal connections (not included).
